1. SEYDN Hub Funding

Grants of between £200 and £2,000 are available to hub members. See Funding Criteria for details. Deadline for applications is **Friday 4 June 2010**.

3. Managing a Successful Youth Dance Company

This one-day course has been commissioned by Hampshire Dance and Sadler's Wells. It will provide an overview of the various aspects of setting up, running and developing a successful youth dance company. It will give you an insight into policy and procedures, good practice, health & safety and help you identify your strengths and weaknesses. The course will include open discussion, self-enquiry and reference to a number of key case studies. Participants will all receive a course handbook at the end of the day.

Cost £45 (£25 for Freelancers) Active Hub members are entitled to an £8 discount. Please quote the code **HUBSP10** when booking in order to claim your discount.

4. YDE Conference 2010

The YDE Conference 2010 will take place at The Mermaid Conference and Events Centre, London on 23rd -24th September. The early bird rates for those who book before 11 June 2010 are:

Public sector - £262.50

Employed in an organisation – £225

Freelancers - £142.50

There are four bursaries of £200 available to active hub members who work mainly on a freelance basis (one bursary per hub area.) This is intended to cover the cost of a place at the conference and a contribution towards travel and accommodation.

5. Careers Events

Hampshire Dance has a small number of grants available for active hub members wishing to put on a dance careers event in their local area. Events must take place between September 2010 and February 2011. Those hub members who are successful in securing a grant will receive a free Dance Careers Event Toolkit to help with the planning and management of the event.

Grant amount = £750. Match funding of at least £250 is expected.

6. Dance Links course and bursaries

Dance Links is a two-day residential training course. The course gives participants working in any dance style the chance to develop their skills and experience in delivering dance in schools, both within and beyond the curriculum.

This year, in the south east, the training will take place on 11th/12th September in Winchester. (Please note the course is also being run in Manchester and Birmingham.)

The course costs £75 and this includes accommodation and meals.
